



Summer Term 1 - Year 4

I am warrior! I am strong, brave and powerful! Meet me in battle. Draw your sword, wield your axe and challenge me if you dare! Invade and attack, Romans versus the Celts, the fight is on...

Maths:

The children will learn about fractions, geometry and co-ordinates during the next half term. Finding equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and recognising decimal equivalents are some of the concepts that will be taught.

English:

The children will write a historical story based upon the Romans, then use this plot to write a playscript and finally write a Roman menu or invitation.

Art, design & technology:

Pupils will have the opportunity to design and make Roman or Celtic shields to form part of their classroom display. Children will also further develop their observational drawing skills.

History:

The children will learn about the Roman Empire and its impact upon life in Britain. Learning will focus upon the Roman invasion, Boudicca and the Celtic revolt and how and why Hadrian's Wall was built.

Physical development: In our PE lessons the children will focus on athletics and gymnastics. In athletics, the children will improve the quality and consistency of the techniques they use for specific activities. In gymnastics, lessons will focus on balance – move into and from balances with control and accuracy. Kingfishers will continue to attend swimming lessons.

Science:

The topic that will be taught this term will be 'Sound'. The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of sound through practical work and learn about scientific concepts such as vibration and pitch. There will be opportunities to develop working scientifically skills such as fair and comparative testing.

RE:

The theme for this term is 'God's Transforming Power'. Work will focus upon the effect of the Holy Spirit on Peter's life and ordinary Christians today. The Christian festival calendar will be also be studied.
