Job Vacancies

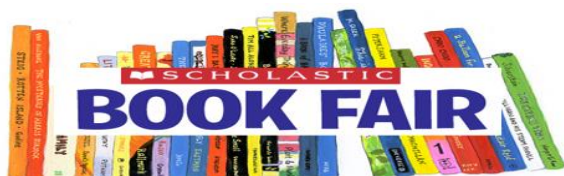
George-Carey Primary School has the following 3 vacancies available:
