<p>Spellings</p> 	<p>This week's spellings will be words containing the ai, ee and oo digraphs and our non-decodable words which your child has been practising during their phonic lessons this week.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Next week we will be continuing with our counting skills by ordering numbers. Can you practise ordering numbers with your child? For example; ordering numbers from 0-10 from biggest to smallest or smallest to biggest. If you feel brave go to 50!</p>
<p>English (reading and writing)</p> 	<p>Please hear your child read every day for 5-10minutes and record with a comment in their reading diary.
