Tuck and in enjoy! A yummy journey of discovery. Children will work up an appetite with delicious stories about food, get busy in the kitchen making tasty dishes and discover how food helps you grow fit and strong.

Here's a food for thought. If you are what you eat-what does that make you?

Maths: The children will be learning about subtraction using the standard method and multiplication including, multiplying by 3,4,8 and solving multiplication problems. Children will also be practising mental maths using RockStar Math.

English: The children will be writing in a variety of genres; instruction writing (recipes), Adverts, Recount and Nonsense poetry.

History: The children will learn about various the history of chocolate, research where food comes from and the importance of Fair Trade.

Music: The children will learning songs linked with food and chocolate, singing in rounds and composing music using fruit and vegetables.

Computing: Researching Mr Cadbury and creating a PowerPoint using a range of features.

Physical development: In our PE lessons the children will focus on net/wall court games. Throwing and catching skills will be developed and then used in games such as badminton. Children will also have weekly fencing lessons.

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RE: In RE children will be studying the message of Christmas. They will be exploring the festival of Christingle and the significant of light. Children will also learn about the period of Advent and the meaning of the Nativity story today in 2017.

PSHE: In PSHE we will be discussing differences within family dynamics and understanding the importance of including others.

Homework: The children will be set homework on a weekly basis and will be expected to hand it in on time. Work will consist of a reading, maths and topic/literacy activity plus weekly spellings. Children are expected to read every day. The reading diary must be signed by an adult.

Science: The children will learn about living things including the human skeleton. They will be learning about a healthy diet, bones in their body and their functions and the job of muscles. All will be done through scientific investigation, testing predictions and writing conclusions.

Art & Design: Children will be designing and making an imaginary fruit using clay. Children will also be designing and making a package for their fruit and their own chocolate factory. .
