Below you have a range of activities to complete. You MUST complete at least 5 of these- one per week. Tick which activities you have completed.

<p>Create a fact file about the Northern Lights.</p>  <p>What are they? Where can you see them? Why do they occur? And so on.</p> <p>You could choose to create a PowerPoint and email it the school office- or print it out and stick inside your home learning book. Why not make a short movie about them?</p>	<p>How would your pet survive in the Arctic Circle or Antarctica? (if you do not have a pet imagine a cat or dog) How would they have to adapt their appearance in order to survive? Think about their fur/feet etc.. Could you give your pet a real 'Polar' name so it would be more in keeping with its new habitat?</p> 	<p>WORD PUZZLES</p> <p>Can you create a word puzzle like a crossword or a word search for a grown up in your home?</p> <p>Remember to use key facts and vocabulary about the Arctic Circle and Antarctica</p> <p>Do your research first!</p> 	<p>Polar Collage</p> <p>Using lots of images and materials linked to Polar regions can you create a Collage?</p> <p>Remember to use: different textures, patterns, colours, shapes. This can be in your book or maybe on a large piece of cardboard.</p> 
<p>Imagine you work for a travel company – you have been given the task to design a brochure that will persuade tourists to visit the Antarctic or Arctic Circle.</p> <p>How will you persuade them? What will you tell them about the Arctic Circle?</p> <p>Use all of the persuasive skills you learnt last half term to help your write a poster that will convince people to visit. Include images of things to see. (You can always ask your teacher to let you print some if you do not have access to a computer at home)</p> 	<p>Design a pair of Boots for an Arctic explorer. Label your design with: <i>Materials</i> <i>Key design features</i> <i>Colours</i> <i>Fabrics etc.</i></p> <p><u>Let your imagination run wild!</u></p> 	<p>Can you make a detailed drawing/painting of a Polar animal?</p> <p>Sketch carefully so as to show all the details.</p> <p>Mix paints so that the colours are true to the real thing.</p>  <p>Which Polar animal will you choose?</p> <p>These will go on display- come on make yours amazing!</p>	<p>Who has explored the Arctic or Antarctica?</p> <p>Find out about an explorer and write a short biography about them. Maybe you might want to make a mini book about them.</p> <p>Did they survive?</p> <p>Are they still alive?</p> <p>What made them want to explore?</p>
