Breakfast Club and After School Club Fees – Due to the high demand for breakfast club and after school clubs we have had to increase the members of staff that supervise these sessions. In addition to this, rising costs mean that we will need to make a small increase of 50p to the price of clubs beginning the week of 16th April 2018. Breakfast club will be £3.00 without breakfast and £3.50 with breakfast. After school club will be £3.50 per hour and £7.00 for 2 hours.

Sports Personality of the Year Award

On Thursday 15th March 2018 the Canary Wharf Group held their 17th annual Sports Personality of the Year awards. There were over 100 people nominated to win this award and only six were shortlisted. Out of those six Mr Ahmed was chosen to receive this award due to his outstanding commitment in the London Borough of Tower Hamlets for his contribution to sports in the community and his involvement in the Soul FC football organisation which was established in 2003. Mr Ahmed, on a weekly basis, trains and manages groups of young children in the surrounding community to help give them purpose and something they can engage in. In 2017 Mr Ahmed took his under 16's boy's football team to take part in the Dana Cup Youth Tournament in Denmark. The Dana Cup is an annual youth football festival where many former international players from all over the world have taken part including two world cup winners. This was a great achievement for the team as they were the first local team in London to make it to the finals. Unfortunately the team lost to a successful pro Norwegian academy team. We would like to say a very big well done to Mr Ahmed and congratulate him on receiving this award for his hard work, determination and passion in the work he continues to do with the community and our school.
