



Summer Term 2 - Year 3

Hop on the Bus and take a trip down town where the lights are bright and every street has a story to tell. Explore with fresh eyes the art of the city, then capture a moment in time- perhaps a reflection on a building or a shadow passing by. Make a map of your home town and find out how things have changed. Has time changed town life for the better?

Maths:

The children will be learning about Time. They will investigate how to tell the time and measure and compare time in seconds, minutes and hours. They will work out how to change minutes to seconds and from seconds to minutes.

Art & Design:

The children will be working in the style of different graffiti artists. We will be researching artists such as STIK and Banksy. They will have the opportunity to create their own Graffiti designs using spray paints.

Physical development:

In our PE lessons the children will continue to focus on summer sports e.g. rounders and tennis. They will also be getting ready for sports day and therefore doing a lot of sports day preparations. The children will also continue fencing for the last term.

Urban Pioneers

Geography: The children will explore their local area and look at maps of Barking Town Centre/Barking Riverside and use this to identify key features. Children will create their own maps of Riverside using keys and symbols.

History: To create a mind map of our local area of Barking Riverside/Barking Town. They will discover what the local area was like in the past and investigate how local life can be improved. Children will also predict what the future of local town will look like.

Computing

This term children will continue to look at branching databases. Within this unit they will learn how to sort data using yes and no questions and create their own database to sort information.

English:

The children will be exploring free verse poetry and comparing Urbanisation to space. They will also be learning how to write autobiographies and write one on anonymous artist Banksy.

Science:

During the summer term, the children will explore Sun Safety, making shadows and changing shadows. They will also look at Thomas Edison on the invention of the light bulb and create a fact file.
