George Carey Has Talent

Last week we received some exciting news about one of our students, Jada from Year 3. Jada took part in the CRG World Dancing Competition on the 20th October 2018 and the Yorkshire Open Irish Dance Championships on the 27th in October 2018. Jada won an incredible 9 trophies in total for her participation in these competitions.

Although Jada has only danced for 18 months she has now come 7th in the world rankings in the Under 10's category (and she is only 7 years old). In the world championships she won all of the solo dances in her category and was 'pushed up' the age group in almost every event, dancing against children older than herself. She has also become the 'Open Champion of Champions', which means that she has won against all of the champions in other age groups.

Jada had this to say about her experience.

'My name is Jada and last month I took part in the Irish Dancing World Championship. Every week for one year trained very hard for this competition. I won the under 9's reel, under 8's slip jig and heavy jig and the under 7's hornpipe dance. For the world championships in Ireland I came home with 5 trophies and 1 medal. I am very happy and proud because I danced so well. My family is also very proud of my achievements'.

We would like to say a big well done to Jada and also add that we as a school are very proud of Jada and her achievements.
